### 6. Residents' Car Parking Consultation

The council sent out 2123 letters. 266 people responded ie 12%.

54% wanted no change to hours

72% zones to remain

66% wanted zones to remain as are

Do WERA want to ask council to ask Uni to ban student cars, except for if student needs them for their course. Agreed.
