6. Street wardens/Bins. – SL

There is a new online system for reporting bins left out. It is a bit cumbersome, and so RL made a Freedom of Information request to see how many fines were issued for bins left out. In the year to date, there were only 13 fines issued for the whole city. SL will bring up the issue at CCF to see whether it is worth reporting the bins if nothing is being done about them. JA suggested that we could do training for the Street Wardens to help them learn how to use the new system. It could also be publicised on WERA facebook and website for all West Enders to use.
